- 4) **Chairman's Annual Report**: Fred Burgess had an address which he did not read out however it is attached to these minutes. You will have a Club Application form/Team Application form and for U16s a venue form, all to be completed in order that we can get the League sanctioned for the 5th August or we will incur a late penalty fine.
